- You may resume your regular activity.

What to Expect

- It is normal to have pink color in your urine after your procedure. You may pass a few small blood clots the first few times you urinate.
- Expect to have burning or stinging the first several times you urinate.
- To reduce painful bladder spasms:
 - Drink plenty of water.
 - Sit in warm bath water.

Medicines

When to Call

Call your doctor if you:

- Have a fever higher than 100°F (37.8°C)
- Have pain that is not controlled by your pain medicine
- Cannot urinate
- It is more than 48 hours after your procedure and you still have stinging or burning when you urinate



Be sure to call your doctor if you have any of the symptoms listed under "When to Call."
